It is the role of the school to

It is the responsibility of the school to

- Work collaboratively with parents and the community when making decisions, however, it is always the school's responsibility to make the final call
- Provide thorough lessons to students in class that meets their needs and is grounded in educational best practice

It is the role of the parent to

- Participate in the education of their child
- Communicate productively with the school director and teachers
- Support the child at home in both their academic and emotional development

It is the responsibility of the parent to

- Work collaboratively with the teacher to follow any measures needed at home (homework, activities etc)
- Ensure that students attend when they should and that absences are explained to the school
- Support the decisions of the school with an understanding that they have been made with the best interests of all students in mind and are grounded in experience and educational theory
